Reports:

Cemetery:

1. Cemetery Deed #588 was reviewed and signed.

Fire & EMS:

- 1. Chief Wilburn presented application for membership for Andrew Kashmer. It will be reviewed at Officer's meeting on April 8.
- 2. Trustees reviewed email sent by Assistant Chief McGinnis regarding State Board of Pharmacy Inspections happening around the area.

Roads:

- 1. Fiscal Officer reported that \$6448 was spent on 147 tons of road salt this year that was not planned for in the budget. This may require a supplemental appropriation later in the year for Operating Expenses.
- 2. Discussion took place regarding truck repairs for the 2002 Freightliner at OCTA. Bev Haar moved to accept verbal quote from OCTA to Road Superintendent, Jason Bickley, on 3/22 of \$800 plus labor for new radiator for 2002 Freightliner. Jerry Haar seconded the motion to approve payment to OCTA for \$800 plus labor for new radiator, stating that the part alone can typically be upwards of \$4000. **Motion carried**.
- 3. Trustees reviewed letter sent to J. Haar by Ottawa Soil & Water Conservation District regarding Held Ditch inspection and erosion issues, along with his acreage that drains into Held Ditch.

Zoning:

1. Dan Laity presented Draft Rev 2 of Harris Township Zoning Resolution for Trustee review. It includes proposed additions, deletions, and Ottawa County Planning recommendations. Copies have also been given to Harris Township Zoning Commission members for review with a goal to have it approved for presentation to the county on May 5.

Other:

- 1. Records purge is ongoing. Trustees discussed destruction of documents through AccuShred, either on site or hauling offsite to their facility. Carol Baker moved to arrange for on-site destruction with AccuShred, and a container to be left for ongoing records purge. Fees for on-site destruction are \$95, which they estimate would hold about 21 banker boxes of documents, or 510 pounds, and \$49 per quarter for the ongoing container shred bin. Beverly Haar seconded the motion. **Motion carried**.
- 2. Fiscal Officer has arranged with OTARMA insurance representative for a renewal review of our current policy. Representative will be present on April 16 at 6:30 if Trustees would like to attend.
- 3. Reviewed correspondence from Verizon regarding opportunity to quote our telephone system, PJ's Cemetery Mapping Service, Coro-Ex invitation for safe digging training, and announcement from Dolph Oil that they have joined with Corrigan Oil Company.
- 4. Request for sponsorship of Elmore Fireworks. A motion was made by Beverly Haar to contribute \$250; Carol Baker seconded. **Motion carried**.

There being no further business, a motion to adjourn was made by Jerry Haar and seconded by Carol Baker. Chairman Beverly Haar declared the meeting duly adjourned at 8:56 pm.
